Subject: Request for Expression of interest (EOI) for recruitment of Short term consultant at CDMP-II under DPHE to conduct a study on the community base of drinking water supply management in the face of climate change.

The Office of the Executive Engineer, Store Division, Dhaka, Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) intends to proceed for procurement of services from national consultants for the post of Short term consultant at CDMP-II under DPHE to conduct a study on the community base of drinking water supply management in the face of climate change.

The consultant's main objects is to identify, test and replicate feasible alternative of safe water provision for the community in the high risk areas. This provision should be cost effective. The Consultant shall be responsible for finding a sustainable technology for the community based drinking water supply management.

The service includes but not limited to:

- Field visit.
- Data collection from existing various type community based drinking water supply in high risk areas and also exchange view with the community through FGD, interviews etc.
- Exchange views with local administrations; local government and DPHE field officials.
- Data analysis and feedback.
- Comparative study on various options fielded already from the context of sustainability.
- Find out the advantage and disadvantage of various type community based drinking water supply management in respect of social and technical aspects.
- Share the knowledge/findings with Project Director, Documentation and Monitoring officer and other staffs during study.
- Innovation of new community based water supply option.
- Present the draft final report in a meeting/workshop.

Qualification and Experiences required for the assignment are:

- Post graduation in Water Supply/Civil/Environmental/Water Resource/ Sanitary Engineering
- At least 5 years experience in WATSAN.
- Preference will be given for having experience of similar research in Water Sector.

Duration of the Assignment

The duration of the assignment will be for 06 (Six) months. But this will depend on performance of the individual in the position.

Remuneration

The consultant will be paid a negotiable consolidated remuneration inclusive of all applicable Taxes and VAT as per law of Bangladesh. Payment shall be made upon satisfactory performance output certified by the Approving Authority.

Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) now seeks applications from eligible Applicants to indicate their interest in providing the services.
