The Peoples Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Emergency Assistance Project (ADB Project No.52174-001), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE), Local Government Division (LGD), Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperative (MLGRDC), ("the Purchaser") invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Supply of Water Carriers(07 Nos, 3000L) for Emergency Water supply including operation and maintenance for 2 years, in Cox's Bazar, Ukhiya and Teknaf.
3. Open competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: One-Envelope procedure and is open to all bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
 - Contractual Experience: Participation as a supplier, in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last 03 years and that is similar to the nature, and complexity in accordance with the scope of supply where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds Bangladesh Taka (BDT 40,000,000.0 (Bangladeshi Taka forty million).
 - Average Annual Turnover: Minimum average annual construction turnover of BDT 65,000,000 (Bangladesh Taka Sixty Five Million only) calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, with in the last 3 (three) years.
 - Financial Resources: Availability of or access to liquid assets, lines of credit, and other finances sufficient to meet cash flow requirement which is BDT 50.0 million
